**A Vibrant Victorian Seaport Village** – Once a vibrant, Victorian seaport village, charming downtown Fernandina Beach escaped the mass commercialization of the 20th century and boasts a beautiful 50-block historic district with many original structures dating back to the late 19th century, including many Victorian-style mansions and Victorian cottages.

Once arriving we will divide into groups where docents will guide us through the historical district and narrate the history of the area, which includes the underground slave route.

Fernandina Beach is the only city in the United States to have been under the domain of 8 different national flags.
